I feel we are unique and essential to the community as we are the only business in the Cumberland area that provides boarding 365 days a year for your family pet.

Q10. What is the plan for using the grant money (How will it be used)?

We would use the grant money towards updating our ventilation, adding 2 air exchange fans to keep airflow through the building while we are at high capacity. Adding 2 mini splits, as we are using 3 portable AC units which is not financially feasible long term. We have also talked to Schell Electric about adding a generator to keep the building temperature controlled during power outages.

We have continued to see an increase in business over the past 5 years. There is a shortage of dog care facilities in our area and we are a local established business people trust. I feel long term we are a very viable business as most people have a family dog or cat and they will need a safe, reliable place for them to stay while going out of town. By receiving the grant money, I would be able to save thousands in electrical costs each year, which I would be able to put towards adding outdoor fenced in runs and updating indoor areas as well.
