Additionally, the business is a authorized U-Haul dealer and provides installation and maintenance of ignition interlock systems (devices installed in vehicles to prevent intoxicated driving).

JCD Services takes pride in being a contributing part of the Cumberland community by supporting local activities such as youth sports, Back the Blue and the Cumberland High School Work Release Program to provide an opportunity for kids to learn mechanics. JCD Services utilizes several local suppliers including Auto Value and George's Ace Hardware for parts and accessories. We stive to support local businesses within a 15-mile radius. JCD Services is unique in that it provides specialized services that are not available elsewhere in the community in addition to the primary auto and marine repair business. It is the only U-Haul dealer in Cumberland and provides a local place for community members, so they do not have to travel elsewhere. The three ignition interlock options which JCD Services offers are the only ignition interlock companies in Cumberland.

JCD Services has been a staple in Cumberland for 18 years and has added additional unique services to community members. JCD has worked hard to keep prices affordable for customers, resulting in the business not having resources to update bathroom facilities. This grant would help support the addition of a restroom facility that would be ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliant. Currently, the only restroom available to customers is a port-a-potty, which is not ADA compliant. This current situation is not ideal and includes additional costs for the business.

The project would be completed using several local businesses and provide long-term savings and better experiences for the customers. The improved facility would have the opportunity to provide additional services to customers, which will improve the local business community overall.
