The Toftness Building is an iconic building on Main Street Cumberland. When we purchased the building we knew some work was needed and it has turned out to be more than we anticipated. Each room has brought challenges, for example the front entry way roof had a leak over the years caused damage to the waiting room walls. We had the roof repaired and now the inside wall needed to be replaced from the damage. We rent space back to Dr. Toftness and Dr. Griffin as well as Karl Ader for Island City Counseling. We have another room almost ready for rental and we have remodeled a lower-level room for use for small meetings or conferences. We waited to purchase windows which are needed badly until we could get all the window AC units out of service. We installed two Mini split systems for summer AC and heat in the fall and spring. The last two window AC units should be out in the next several weeks. We are trying to maintain the 76 year old architecture as possible.
