We have made progress on getting the locals back in and will continue to move in that direction with additional advertising, changing up our menu, as well as several other planned changes. I own a trailer moving business, but being in winter season, I am not bringing any profit in to help with the bar (unfortunate timing). The township is currently working in our favor for us to get our liquor license to help us succeed and this could take months to get an answer, if that does not work out, we plan on getting a reserve liquor license. We have high hopes that the bar is going to thrive again, and soon, and once that happens, I would like to become a member of 50 people who care to give back to the community. I'm in awe that this exists and would be extremely grateful for this help.
