It gives local residents a place to shop not only on the weekends. We also area store that carries a wide variety of discounted boys/girls & baby items. The items are always new and always changing. About 80% of the store items are unique - one and gone, so our inventory is always changing. Along, with baby & kid items we also carry women's clothing, accessories and gifts.

Another thing that makes Tiny Friends & More unique is it is a dream of a young entrepreneur who happens to have a disability and does not drive. Carly always wanted a "career" and her dream was to own a store.

This grant money will be used to make a handicap accessible entrance at the back of our store in the alley - which will allow for more accessibility.

We would also like to do some general maintenance - replace windows, flooring, add some insulation, look at the roof, etc.

Some of the money would be used for inventory and bringing in some new Cumberland items into the store, as well as being used to put on some more "events" to attract more people to main street.
